OVERVIEW

LCA

- LCA = Leaving Certificate Applied
- Two Year Leaving Certificate Programme aimed at preparing students for adult and working life.
- Marked differently than traditional Leaving Certificate.
- Students are rewarded for Project Work

Why Study Leaving Applied Programme?

Who is LCA aimed at?

- Students who are preparing for the world of work.
- Students who work well at and who enjoy project work.
- Students who work well in a supported learning environment.
- Students who work well on short term goals.

Why I Chose LCA

- I prefer practical work to theory work.
- I prefer project work to exams.
- It gives you the opportunity to do work experience.
- It suited me best.
- I liked the variety of subjects.
- What I liked was that you got credits as you went on.

What are Credits?

- <u>Credits</u> are marks that are give to the student after completing each key assignment or piece of work.
- Each subject has **Modules**.
- Each Module has **four key assignments.**
- Each Module has **two credits**.
- You need credits to pass each subject.
- There are **200 Credits overall** in LCA.

| 7 Final Exams Total: 200 Credits | 68 credits (34%) |

Requirements:

90% Attendance

 Evidence of the completion of four key assignments for each module/subject

- Information and Communication Technology
- Arts Education

Formal Examinations

- English & Communications
- Mathematical Applications
- Language 1 in each year
- Vocational Specialisms (Practical and written)
- Social Education

How is LCA Marked?

At the end of the two years you get:

```
• Distinction 85-100 % (170 - 200 credits)
```


```
• Merit 70-84 % (140 - 169 credits)
```

• Pass 60-69 % (120 - 139 credits)

- If you would like to go to a University or an I.T. after LCA you must first do a PLC course.
- A PLC course usually takes a year.
